and then back again.

the scale in one even motion. The scale in each pattern is played from the lowest note on the sixth string to the highest note on the first string

Try to maintain your hand position moving from string to string. Practice and note the finger positions. Also practice linking into adjacent patterns or skipping a pattern into a new position.
