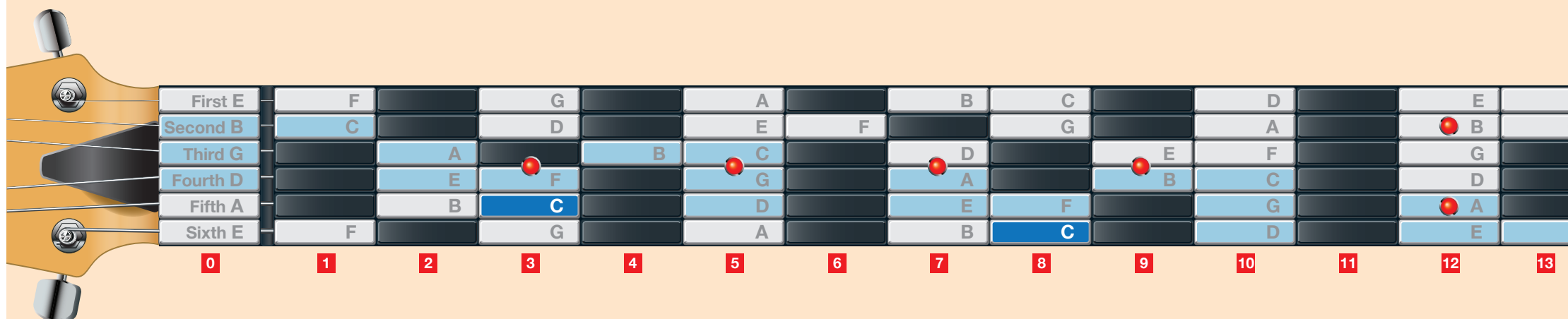
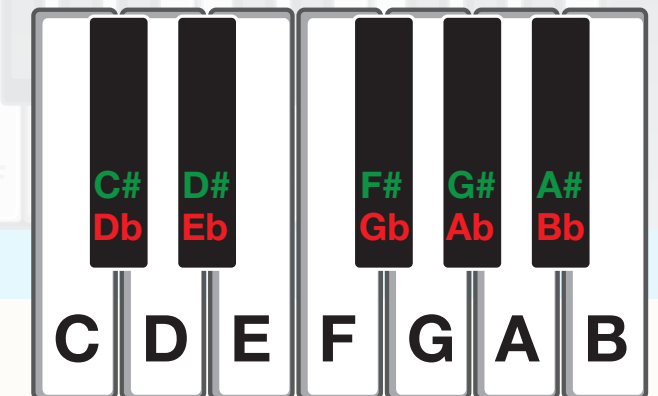
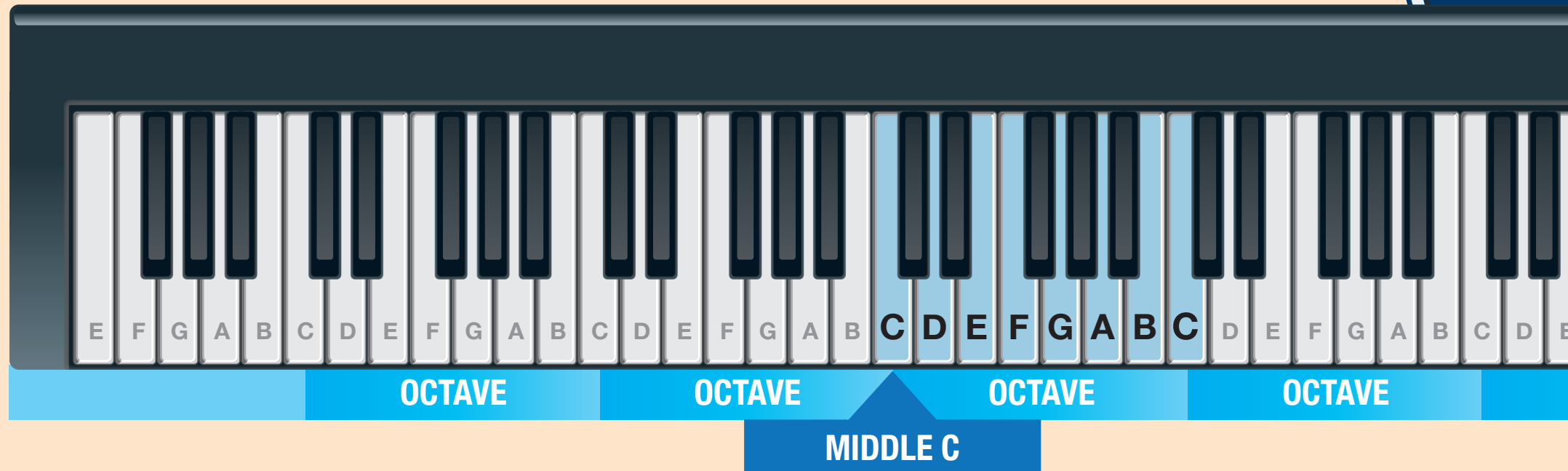


NOTES ON THE GUITAR

The range is considered to be from the open E on the sixth string to the high E on the 12th fret of the first string. After the 12th fret the notes are repeated an octave higher. Notice that on the guitar there is more than one place where you can play the same note.

NOTES ON THE KEYBOARD

On a keyboard it is easy to see the notes of the diatonic C Major scale. The 8 white keys starting and finishing on the C note make up one octave with the black (sharp or flat) notes in between. The range of the keyboard is extended by repeating the notes across several octaves.



SHARPS & FLATS ON GUITAR

It is not so easy to see the sharp and flat notes on a guitar neck. If a guitar was laid out like a keyboard it might look something like this. Try to become familiar with the pattern created by the sharp and flat notes.
